

Will Docket July Term 1852

Richard Sumner's will.

"In the name of God Amen!

"I Richard Sumner being aged & infirm, but, thanks be to
 " God of perfect mind & memory, but calling to mind the mortality
 " of my body, and knowing that it is appointed for all men
 " once to die; do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament:
 " that is to say: First of all I recommend my soul into the
 " hands of Almighty God who gave it; and I recommend my
 " body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at
 " the discretion of my surviving friends, and as touching such
 " worldly Estate, wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in
 " this life, I give and bequeath in the following manner & form:
 " first all my just debts are to be paid, as I have heretofore given
 " to all my Children excepting Dempsey, near the amount I
 " allowed them to have out of my Estate, so I now give and bequeath
 " unto my daughter Susannah Whitaker, the sum of Twenty Dollars
 " likewise the sum of One Dollar each of my other daughters,
 " Sarah McCrary & Judy Clemmens; also the like sum of One dollar
 " to my son William; likewise the sum of One Dollar to the heirs
 " of my son Samuel; also I give the like sum of One Dollar to the
 " heirs of my daughter Elizabeth Jones dec'd. likewise I give the
 " like sum of One dollar to the heirs of my son James; I further
 " give and bequeath unto my son Dempsey all these tracts of land
 " I now own, it being two Hundred & forty five Acres, together
 " with all my horses, cattle, hogs, Sheep and Stock of every
 " description, together with all my farming tools & working tools of
 " every description; also all my house hold and kitchen furniture
 " of every description, including all my bedding, clothing and all
 " property included in my houses, and out of the value of said
 " property said Dempsey is to pay the aforesaid Legates, the afove
 " mentioned sum of One Dollar each; and I the said Richard
 " Sumner do hereby ratify and confirm this my last Will &
 " Testament, hereby revoking, disannulling and setting aside
 " all other former Wills & Testaments by me at any time heretofore
 " made; I also nominate, constitute & appoint my son Dempsey
 " as my sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament. In Witness
 " whereof, I have set my hand & seal, in the presence of
