I Robert Robert of the State of North Carolina and County of
Buncombe being in but indifferent health but of sound
and perfect mind and memory do hereby bequeath
Do this 10th day of April in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and forty make and publish
this my last will and testament in form and manner
following. Viz. First I resign my body to the dust
to be buried in Christian form and my soul to
God who have it
I have and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary -
Robert all my House hold and kitchen furniture for
her to have and keep for ever or for her to dispose of
as she has proper by will or otherwise and I also
bequeath to her my 10 wife all my stock of every description
with three negroes viz. Jaden Job Larkins with to in
because of sickness for her to have and keep during her
natural life and at her death the stock and negroes to
be sold and equally divided among all my children
Also I bequeath to my said wife and her heirs 10 dollars
when collected out of debt that is owing to me
I have and bequeath to my son William Robert one
negro girl named Abnera for her to have and
keep with her increase for ever
I have and bequeath to my son Robert Robert one
negro boy called Perry to have and keep the same
forever. I have and bequeath to my son John
Robert ten dollars. I have and bequeath to my
daughter Levisa Futers one negro girl named
Mabel for her to have and keep with her in
because forever but I will that these girls be
and remain with my wife during her
natural life except when my wife she proxy
to have her up to 10 Levisa Futers and my
wife not in keeping or giving up the girls is
entirely my will. I have and bequeath to my son
William Robert ten dollars. I have and bequeath
to my son Augustus K. Robert one tract of land
I hold on himself for the amount of fifty
dollars. I have and bequeath to my son
James Robert one negro boy called Perry
to have and keep forever. I have and
bequeath to my son Abner K. Robert

I have and bequeath to my Grand sons Robert Martin Robert
and Andrew Martin Robert one tract of land where my
son William Robert now lives and one negro girl
called Sally for them to have and keep for ever but the
said land and negro to be and remain entirely under
the control and management of the Executors of this my last
will and testament hereafter named.
I have and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Elizabeth K.
Robert one negro girl called Mary to have and keep the
same for ever to be under control of Executors as above
I have and bequeath to my son Robert Robert (over and
above what I have given him in a previous time)
one tract of land containing fifty acres forming Charles
McKinney Lot & backer and my said son Robert
Also one other tract forming W. Anderson and the
Crews tract I have to my said son Robert and
I ordain and make my two sons James Robert and
Alfred K. Robert Executors to this my last will and
testament in witness I the said Robert Robert
doth hereunto set his hand and seal
