The last will and testament of Sarah Ann Lane  
of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina I  
Sarah Ann Lanee Conscerning the uncertainty of this world  
life and being of sound mind and memory blessed be almighty  
God for the same do make and publish this my last will  
and testament in manner and form following That is to say  
first I give and bequeath unto my beloved Grandaughter  
Mary Ann Murray of the County of Buncombe one feather  
My best bed and all equipment of the necessary bed clothing  
one Cupboard and all the furniture such as deth and glass  
ware belonging to it also one felling toll and one chest  
and I further give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Eliza  
Murray of the aforesaid County all and every my personal or  
real estate such as I am now seized and possessed of or  
may become mine previous to my death I further give  
and devise to my said daughter Eliza Murray my two negroes  
Bill and Ann which I allow to be divided and directed that  
the said negroes at my decease be given in charge to  
W.M. Murray the husband of my said daughter Eliza Murray  
for her and her bodies heirs and lawys special and full  
use and benefit and my will and meaning is that in case  
my daughter or Grandaughter deport this life before such  
time as my death I then and in that case will give  
and bequeath the foregoing named negroes Bill and Ann  
together with the aforesaid bed and bedding Cupboard deth  
and glass ware furniture to go to and to be equally  
divided as near as may be between my dear daughter  
Eliza Murray and her heirs the said Bill and Ann are not  
to be sold but to be left in the care and charge of  
W.M. Murray for the special use and benefit and behoof of the  
aforesaid Eliza Murray her said heirs after her the said  
Eliza Murray deceas I do further bid and bequeath to my several  
children Samuel R. Lane Joseph Lane Sally Troxey Rowdy more  
one dollar each as also one dollar to the children of Henry R.  
Lane second to be paid to each of the aforesaid last named of  
my children on my decease I do further hereby appoint  
the said W.M. Murray my sole Executor of this my last  
will and testament hereby breaking all former wills by me  
made in witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand  
and seal the 12<sup>th</sup> day of May 1833 Sarah Ann Lanee (SS)
