The last will and testament of Sarah Ann Lane
 of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina I
 Sarah Ann Lane considering the uncertainty of the world
 life and being of sound mind and memory do hereby
 last for the same so make and publish this my last will
 and testament in manner and form following that is to say
 first I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son daughter
 Mary Ann Murry of the County of Buncombe one feather
 my bed and a full equipment of the necessary bed clothing
 one Culhara and all the furniture such as delf and Elap
 ware belonging to it also one felling toll and one chest
 and I further give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Eliza
 Murry of the aforesaid County all and every my personal and
 real estate such as I am now seized and possessed of or
 may become mine previous to my death I further give
 and devise to my said daughter Eliza Murry my two negro
 Bill and Ann which I allow to be sold and direct that
 the said negroes at my direction be given in charge to
 W. H. Murry the husband of my said daughter Eliza Murry
 for her and her bodies heirs (ad law) special and full
 use and benefit and my will and meaning is that in case
 my daughter or Son shall depart this life before such
 time as my death I then and in that case will give
 and bequeath the foregoing named negroes Bill and Ann
 together with the aforesaid bed and bedding Culhara delf
 and Elap ware furniture to go to and to be equally
 divided as near as may be between my dear daughter
 Eliza Murry body heirs the said Bill and Ann are not
 to be sold but to held and kept in the care and charge of
 W. H. Murry for the special use and benefit and behoof of the
 aforesaid Eliza Murry her said body heirs after her the said
 Eliza Murry decease I do further bind and bequeath to my sons
 Children Samuel R. Lane Joseph Lane Polly Henry Henry
 one dollar each as also one dollar to the children of Henry R.
 Lane so as to be paid to each of the aforesaid last named of
 my children on my decease I do further hereby appoint
 the aforesaid W. H. Murry my sole Executor of this my last
 will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me
 made in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal the 12th day of May 1853 Sarah ^{for} Ann Lane (S)
