

Will I do to July 1865
 Know all men by these presents that I Sophronia
 Davidson of the County of Buncombe
 and State of North Carolina, do make constitute and
 ordain this to be my last Will and testament viz,
 First, My wish and desire is that my body be decently
 buried with a Christian burial suited to the wishes of
 relatives & friends,

2^d My wish and desire is that my Executor here in
 after named pay off all my just debts of what kind
 out of any money or moneys that may first come into
 his hands together with my funeral expenses, and
 also take into possession all debts of what kind
 that may be owing me at the time of my death
 which will enable him when collected to settle
 off at once,

3^d It is my wish and desire that my youngest
 daughter Mary Louisa have two Beds and sufficient
 furniture also one Bureau the one my Father gave
 me, one large gilt mirror,

4th My wish and desire is that my son Samuel
 Davidson have my Clay bank, Mine my Gold
 watch, one good Bed and furniture and also
 one Rifle gun,

5th It is my wish and desire that the balance of
 my Estate of whatever kind, both real and personal
 be equally divided either by Sale or division as my
 sum most advantageous, by my Executor here in after
 named and the proceeds thereof equally divided
 between my four Children to share alike,

6th My wish is that my Father John Burgin
 and John M. Patten act as my Executors,
 signed Sealed and acknowledged in presence of
