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The Last Will & Testament of Thomas Ingram deceased

In the name of God amen I Thomas Ingram of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina being sound and perfect Mind and Memory. Blessed be God do this day March the 4<sup>th</sup> In the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following

First I give and bequeath that all my just debts be paid

Second I Bequeath unto my half sister Lucare Adkinson the sum five Dollars, my nephew William Adkinson five Dollars my niece Corbelia Reynolds five Dollars and I Bequeath all the rest my property and money to be equally divided amongst Isaac Garmon's Children and I hereby make and ordain my worthy friend W. H. Garmon Executor of this my last will and Testament in writing to him of I the said Thomas Ingram have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and Seal the day and year above written.
