

we do remanence that at a Court of Pleas and
Quarter Sessions opened and held for the County of
Buncombe at the Court house in Asheville on the first
Monday in July, Anno Domini one thousand eight
hundred and thirty two, the following wills were
duly proved in open Court & Recorded.

The last will and testament of William Nelson and
William Nelson of the County of Buncombe and State of North Carolina
do make and ordain this my last will and testament as follows
I give and bequeath unto my son Charles B. Nelson and his wife Celia for
during their natural life for the purpose of supporting and by the
profit thereof conceiving their joint children and thereafter to their said
joint children and their heirs and assigns forever all that lot
of land to one whom the said Charles B. Nelson now lives, lying
in fourth part of my tract of land in the County of Madison
and State of Tennessee, except four hundred acres of said lot of
land conveyed by me to said Charles B. Nelson & his wife Celia
for the purpose of settling and the said four hundred acres of land
for the benefit of themselves and their children; the whole
of said purchase land having surveys and divided into 4 lots
numbered one, two, three and four 12 Sept 1828 by Austin Miller each
lot containing 1230 acres of land more or less.

I give and ambequeath to my son Archibald Nelson & his heirs and executors
of land on Rockfish River in Madison County in State of Tennessee
whereon he now lives containing 440 acres more or less
I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Nelson and my grand
son Euan H. Cope and their respective heirs and assigns, bounded
on said by lot No. 4 conveyed to Charles Ready & Joseph Strong & on
the opposite side by lot No. 2. Conveyed to George Gilaspie. Lot No. 3.
opposite Madison County tract of land containing 1930 acres of
land more or less to be equally divided between said Sarah
Nelson and Euan H. Cope.

I also give and bequeath to my said daughter Sarah Nelson her
heirs and assigns all that part of the tract of land whereon
I now live to be cut off from the lower end of said tract. Beginning
from at a Spring at the lower edge of French broad river bank
marked by Daniel Mathews running from thence a direct course
to my back line of said tract where it crosses N. Harrison
branch thence with said back line running to the tract of
whereon Mr. Rockfish lives thence with the certain lines of said
tract to a walnut tree on the bank of the River the lower end
of my tract of thence with the means of the River

I also give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Neilson
my share of stock five hundred dollars in the Buncombe
Turnpike Company, and all the negroes that I own
on the day of my death. I also give and bequeath to
my daughter Sarah Neilson one half of all my house-
hold furniture, half of all my live stock, half of all
my moveable property whatever I may own at my death.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Jane and her husband
James R. Garrett for and during their natural life the purpose
of raising, educating, supporting and caring for their mutual
children & thereafter to their children & their heirs and assigns
for ever; after being so equally divided amongst them ^{and} between
all the tract of land wherein I now live comprehending

all the property I own in Buncombe County except that
part in the lower end of said tract comprehending twenty acres
already given and bequeathed to my daughter Sarah Neilson
I also give and bequeath unto my said daughter Jane & her
husband James R. Garrett all the remainder of my prop-
erty that is not otherwise devised; out of the money I have
on hand and money to debt due to me my funeral expenses
to be off and my debts (if any) I may at the time of my death
owe. And I do hereby make and ordain William
Dickson, Doctor Alexander Williams, and Archibald Neilson
my son all of Buncombe County, & Co George Gilaspie of Risa County, Tennessee
or any of them Executors of this my last will and testament.

In witness whereof I the said Archibald Neilson have to this
my last will and testament set my hand and seal this 29th
day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and one
