lands of Joseph Vance and Daniel Blalock and
John Ryle; I give and bequeath and devise
all the rest residue and remainder of my Personal
property and debts due me To myt
To my Two Sisters Saphrona As and Permeala As
Murray

Likewise I make constate and appoint
W.R. Murray to be my executor of this my
last will and Testament hereby revoking
all former wills by me made.
