I Catharine Ramsey of the County
of Burke and State of North Carolina
Being of sound mind & memory
but considering the uncertainty of my earthly
existence do make & declare this my last
Will & Testament in manner & form following
that is to say

1st that my Executor herein after named
shall provide for my body a decent burial
and pay all funeral Expences with all my
just debts owen by me out of the First
moneys that may first come in to his hands
as apart or parcel of my Estate

2nd I give to my Son Jonas Ramsey
one Dollar To the Heirs of George Ramsey
Dec one Dollar To the Heirs of Wm Ramsey Dec
one Dollar To my Daughter Elizabeth Franklin
one Dollar and Considering That my youngest
Daughter Ann will be left to the Cold Charity
of the world I Give the Remaining part of my
Personal Property with my intrust in the
Real Estate The Executor to pay all just debts
out of the Property wiled to Ann Ramsey

and lastly I do here by appoint my
Trusty friend Lth Hth Warlick my Lawful
Executor to all intents and purposes

To execute this my last will and testament
I also revoke all wills, testaments by me
here to fore made

to my daughter Elizabeth Franklin One dollar. —
and considering that my youngest daughter Ann will
be left to the cold charities of the world, I give ~~my~~
the remaining part of my personal property with my
interest in the Real Estate, the Executor to pay all just
debts out of the property willed to Ann Ramsey. —

And lastly, I do hereby appoint my trusty friend L.
F. Harlick my lawful Executor to all intents and purposes
to execute this my last Will and Testament. I also revoke
all Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made. —

set my hand and seal this the 7th day of November 1868. —
