Elizabeth Emma Fleming

July Term 1842

Burke Co. NC Wills 1793-1868
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In the name of God amen I Elizabeth Elmore
Flaming of the County of Burke and State of North
Carolina being of wit and feath heath but of
sound and disposing mind and memory do make
and declare this my last will and testament
that is to say First That my executor hereafter named
shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable
to the wishes of my relations and friends and to
have erected over my grave handsome grave
stones with suitable inscriptions thereon

Secondly I will and devise to my mother
Jane Murphy my negro girl Celia my riding
horse if we found and all of my household
furniture and wearing apparel to be disposed of
~~at her death~~ as she thinks proper

Thirdly I will Burke Co. NC Wills 1793-1868
www.northcarolinapioneers.com and devise to my brother
Abraham P. Flaming my interest in the tract
of land on which he now lives called the Potomac-
more place and my interest in the Brock Place
adjoining Jacob Finner to have and his heirs forever

Fourthly I will and devise that my
executor sell at such time and on such
credit as he may deem most advantageous
my undivided interest in lands all the lands
devised to me as heir at law of my Father
Abraham Flaming died lying in the Counties
of Burke and Caldwell (except the lands above
devise) and the proceeds that he divide
the proceeds among ~~therefrom~~ equally among
all of my brothers and sisters

Fifthly I will and devise to my brother
Abraham P. Flaming such claims and monies
as he may be due me with the condition

that he purchase for my sister-in-law Abigail
Thimney and my sister Adeline each a
black bombazine dress
Sixthly I will and do give to my brother John
Thimney my brasses.

Seventhly I will and do give that the expenses
incident to my funeral and all my
debts be paid out of the notes and amounts
due me and should they not be sufficient
that the balance be withdrawn from the
sale of my lands as above directed and
applied to that purpose

Eighthly And I do hereby constitute my brother
Abraham Thimney executor to this my last
will & Testament hereby revoking and
declaring void all other wills and testaments
by me heretofore made

In testimony whereof I have hereunto
subscribed my name and affixed my seal
this 24th day of April 1842
