In the name of God Amen. being now solemnly im-
pressed with a knowledge of the fact that it is appointed
for all men once to die. I James Edwin of Burke in the
State of North Carolina do hereby make, ordain and publish
this paper containing as my last will and Testament
declaring and confirming the same. disavowing and
revoking all other wills heretofore by me made
in the following words and figures (to wit)

1st I will and bequeath that all my debts justly due
shall be paid in all good faith out of my estate by my
Executors hereinafter named.

2nd My further express will is that after my said
debts are fully paid and satisfied that the entire residue
and remainder of all and singular my estate both
Real and Personal shall vest and enure in my
faithful and beloved wife Margaret Edwin solely
to be held in her own right to be used enjoyed and
disposed of as she my said faithful and well beloved
wife Margaret Edwin may see fit, and proper

3rd And do hereby nominate my said wife
Margaret Edwin my sons William & Edwin Joseph
J. Edwin and my son in law Burton George Executors
to this my last will and Testament who are hereby
appointed as such.

of December A. D. 1842
