first place I give to my beloved wife ^{nable} full and an un interrupted
possession of my hole estate ^{that is not otherwise disposed of} and freely to enjoy it in doing her
natrel life ^{or widowhood} and at her Death ~~for the~~ or marriage for the hol
of it to be my Daughter Mabels if she shall take good bear of her
a mother and ser porte and main tane her during her life or
widowed and at her Death or marriage for to pay to Valley ^{in full}
the sum of forty one pounds ^{and} seven shillings and ^{all} pence
so to Hastin Durham my wife Gun all so my waring apparel to be divide
between Hastin and William Durham all so to Betsey Geiby ^{Children} half a Dollar
all's I appoint Isaac Sherit to be my executor of this my last will
and testament and god herby utterly Disallow revoke and disannul all
and every other form testament wills legaces bequests and Executors
by me in any way befor named willed and bequeathed ratifying
and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament
in witness wherof I have hear unto set my hand and seal this
ninth Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
Eight hundred and too in ter Lined be for sined
