the 6th day in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty five Mary Edmiston being
a body but sound in mind do make and ordain this
my last will and testament in the first place
bequeath and will my soul to God who gave it

I will and bequeath all my land, to my two beloved sons
George Edmiston and Joseph Edmiston

the first in case of his death to Joseph Edmiston
to be all cows and calf to George and the most cows and
up to Joseph. Sows and cows and heifer to Mary and
bequeath one load of corn to Alexander to take to
war for the benefit of the house and family and
there be any to spare after the family and the
wishes it is to go to the use of Joseph and Mary
all the farming tools to Alexander and Joseph and
a twenty dollar note to my son in law James
entire to be given up at my death to said partner
