Carolina being weak and feeble in body but of
sound mind and disposing memory, thanks be
to God do make & ordain this my last will &
testament in manner & form following to wit,
Item I give and bequeath the whole of my lands
estate to my Brother Asa Ermin & Ermin &
John Mc Cany W. Ermin & my Nephew Alexander
Hinson to be divided between them share & share
alike to them & their heirs forever & also my
share in the Linville Cove tract between them
& their heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath my Negro man Tom
to my Nephew Alexander Hinson to him
his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath to my Brother John
Mc Cany W. Ermin my Negro woman
Jane to him & his heirs forever

Item I will & bequeath the residue of my Negroes
viz David ~~Sam~~ Amy Jackson Lilla Adeline
be divided share and share alike between
my brother Asa Ermin & I Mc W Ermin
Nephew Alexander Hinson

Item I give & bequeath my Negro woman Lucy
to my Brother Asa Ermin to him & his
heirs forever

Item It is also my will that my brother Asa
Ermin have and take good care of my
old Negro woman Senah during her life
for her services rendered to me from infancy

I now I give & bequeath to my brother John
McLerrin my sorrow mare Sally Brake
stew to him & his heirs forever, not to be parted
with during his natural life on any occasion
whatever & my new Saddle Bridle & Martin
gals.

I now I will and bequeath my gray horse Henry
to my friend William R. Lavender to him
& his heirs forever

I now. It is also my will that, the balance of my
property, except my watch & pictures drawn
by my deceased wife, be sold consisting of
Horses, Hogs, Cattle, farming utensils, Corn
fodder &c household & Kitchen furniture,
except ~~two~~ large Crows, be sold & after paying
my just debts, the residue if any be divided
equally share & share alike between my two
brothers A. H. & I McLerrin & my nephew
Alexander Hinson.

I now. I will & bequeath my watch & establishment
& Looking glass & his share of the pictures
to my brother A. H. McLerrin to him & his heirs
forever,

I now I give and bequeath 1 Looking glass &
his share of the pictures to my brother
John McLerrin to him & his heirs forever
& that ~~him~~ & A. H. McLerrin divide the pictures
between them equally share & share alike.

I now I hereby constitute and appoint my brother
A. H. McLerrin & John McLerrin & my brother
in law, Frankland Hinson, my Executors to
this my last will & testament revoking

all other wills & testaments heretofore made by
me, Given under my hand & seal this 21st
day of August 1833. *Alfred E. Ewing*

The last will & Testament of *Wm. R. Lander*
of Burke County was presented into open Court
by *Alfred E. Ewing* & *Isaac Penley* Jurats
the Executors therein named and proved in
due form of law by the oaths of *Wm. R. Lander*
& *Isaac Penley* subscribing witnesses thereto and
ordered to be recorded and on motion of said
Executors, who took the oath required by law
ordered that letters testamentary & Certificate of
probate be granted unto them
