of the County of Burke and State of North Carolina being of
sound and disposing mind and memory do make publish
and declare this paper writing to be and contain my last
Will and Testament, "to wit" I Resign my Soul unto
Almighty God who gave it and direct my body buried
in a becoming and Christian manner at the discretion
of my friends and that my Executors herein after named pay
my funeral expence out of my Estate, And such worldly
Estate as it hath Almighty God to bestow upon me I
wish it to be disposed of in the following manner "to wit" 1st
I will and bequeath to my dear and beloved Wife
Sophia R. Kincaid All ~~My~~ lands in Burke County
joining Land of B. Bristol, the heirs at law of Col. M^r
Kincaid dec'd & other, during her natural life or Widowhood,
but out of of said land, she is to support my four
youngest Children namely Finley Milton, Alonzo A, Sarah
C & and Lulicia R ~~until~~ ^{until} they become of Age, and after
the death of my beloved Wife Sophia R. Kincaid or
her Widowhood, ~~then or~~ ^{then} my will and bequest
is that all of said ^{lands} pass over and belong to my ^{2^d} youngest
sons Finley M & Alonzo A with a distinct understanding
that out of off of said lands they support their two Sisters
Sarah C & Lulicia R until they attain lawful age.
I also will and bequeath to my beloved wife S R Kincaid
one two horse Waggon, one horse or mule of her own choice,
two Cows and Calves, 10 head of hogs of her choice, 2 pair of
gearing, one truckle, and all the ploughs I have, together
with a support for herself & family out of any crop,
stock or provisions ~~that~~ I may have on hand for one
year.
2 I will and bequeath to my two daughters Sarah C &
Lulicia R. All my household and Kitchen furniture
after the death of my beloved wife Sophia R. Kincaid

30 I will and bequeath to my daughter Jane S. Corpening,
five dollar, to my son James B Kincaid five dollar,
to my daughter Elizabeth C. Largent, five dollar,
to my daughter Margaret Ann Coffey five dollar,
to my son W. Joseph Kincaid five dollar, and
to my daughter Martha C. Sudderth five dollar,
4th All the balance of my personal property I wish
to be sold by my executors and if after paying
my debts there is or should be any money or effects
of said property, I will and bequeath it to my
two youngest daughter, Sarah C. & Leticia R. and
request or will that my executors pay it over to them

And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my
son J. B. Kincaid and my wife Sophia R. Kin-
caid Executor & Executrix of this my last will
and testament,

and publish this my last will and
testament,

In the first place I give bequeath and
devise to my dearly beloved wife
Lorenzo. S. Vincaid all my Estate,
both real personal and mixed
to have and to hold, during her
natural life. And at her death to be
equally divided, between all my
Children or the survivors of them
and in case any of my Children shall
die before my wife leaving child
or children I shall represent their
part in such division —

2^d In case my wife shall intermarry
again it is my will and desire, that
her said life estate in my Estate —
shall terminate. And in that event
all of my Estate real personal and
mixed, shall be divided between
my said wife and my Children
and their representatives, precisely
in the manner provided by Law,
for the distribution of said Estate
in case I had died intestate and
my said wife take the same to the life.

Extent are in the same manner
as in case of intestacy -

3^d It is my desire and I so direct
that my said wife shall at any time
have the power to advance any of
my children out of any of said property,
she may desire from time to time,
and that such child or children, shall
account for all such advancements
in the final settlement and division
of my said estate, except such advan-
cements as may be necessary for their
education, which are not to be accom-
-ted for, this matter of advancements
is to be left to the discretion of my
dear wife -

4th It is my will and desire that
my executor hereinafter ^{mentioned} pay all
my just debts out of the property
bequeathed in the three foregoing
clauses, and the remainder to
stand as heretofore directed -
Lastly, I appoint my friend W. D.
Siddons my sole executor of this
my last will and testament - hereby
revoking all other wills heretofore
made by me, Entertained before signing

I Jacob Gail of the County of
Burke and State of North Carolina being of sound
mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty
of my earthly existence do make and declare
this my last will and testament in manner and
form following that is to say.

First: that my executor herein (after named)
shall provide for my body a decent burial suit-
able to the wishes of my relations and friends and
pay all funeral expences together with all my
just debts whosoever and to whomsoever owing
out of the moneys that may first come into his
hands as a part or parcel of my estate

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Second. I give and devise to my beloved wife
Sixty five acres of land, whereon I now live adjoining
the lands of Philip Marlick J. B. Wilson and J. B. Pugh
to have and to hold to her for and during the term of
her natural life

Third. I give and bequeath to my said beloved wife
Mary Ann. Three head of cattle Nine head of hogs
Four heads and four stags with all the poultry and
provisions on hand together with all my household
and kitchen furniture also one Silver watch, also all
debts owing to me by whomsoever

Fourth. I the said Jacob Gail do will and devise
all the above Stunged property including the real estate
to the sole use and disposal of my said beloved wife
Mary Ann during the term of her natural life
