Item, I give to my daughter Sally McCoy one feather bed and furniture one lining wheel

Item, I give to my son Miles Overton and Benjamin Overton all my lands and it to be equally divided between them when they come of age, and one horse and saddle to Miles Overton, and further more of either dies before they come of age it to go to the survivors

Item I give to my daughter Michael Overton one feather bed and furniture one lining wheel

Item, I give to my daughter Lydy Overton one feather bed and furniture one Bokkat one black horse.

Item I give to my daughter Cortney Overton one feather and furniture or the valuation in money

Item, I send my wife Catron Overton the free use of my hold plantation and all farmin contention within and without, my Cattle Sheep and Hogs, and for her to have the free use of all as long as she remains my widow, and after her death to be equally divided between my gals named Charlet whitcomb Sally McCoy, Michael Overton Lydy Overton and Cortney Overton after paying all my just debts and funeral charges Published this December the 5th day 1820

 hundred and twenty four make and publish this my Last will and

- First Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally the East side of my
 plantation to a Seproing standing in the edge of the Creek Swamp
 called the corner tree between me and Grandy Sawyer, then strate
 across to the house to give her the main body of the house and then
 from the house to a white mulberry tree and from the mulberry
 tree strate down in the branch to the line and one hand mill to her
 and her heirs forever
- 2nd Item The remainder of my Land and Swamp also the shed room I leave
 to my beloved wife during my widowhood and if she shall have
 a child by me I give that part of my Land and Shed room
 to it if it shall live to be twenty one years old or shall have and
 live, to it and to its heirs forever, and if not to go to my daughter
 Sally and her heirs
- 3rd Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife two beds and
 furniture one linen wheel one iron flat iron one case of knives
 and forks all the earthen ware one pewter dish twelve barrels
 of Indian corn sixteen head of hogs one cow and calf two
 ewes and lambs one ax one table three barrels of pork one pot
 all the pottery all the flax and cotton one hackle six tables
 spoons one pair cotton cards one lumb and harness one plow and
 harness and one horse to her and her heirs forever.
- 4th Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Ruth one cow and calf
 to her and her heirs forever.
- 5th Item I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Susana the daughter
 of Ayia Culpepper one bed and furniture one ewe and lamb to her and
 her heirs forever
- 6th Item The remainder of my property not already given away I leave to be
 equally divided between my daughters Polly Ayia Mariam and Ruth
 to them and their heirs forever - And I hereby make and seal
 my brother Nehemiah Riggs Executor of this my Last will and Testament
 in witness whereof I the said Noah Riggs have to this my last will and
 Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written

 all the money and note I leave or my assets to be divided equally
 between them after paying all my just debts
- Item I give and bequeath to my son Sanders Sawyer five shillings
- Item I give and bequeath my son Thomas Sawyer all the remaining
 part of my estate not herein before mentioned, consisting of
 household and kitchen furniture, stock, farming utensils &c. &c. &c.
 and my will is, that if either of my said grand sons Latimore
 John or Thomas Upton should die without an heir lawfully be-
 gotten of his body for the survivor or survivors to have the property
 I have given him or them equally if two should survive out of three
