Will Calit Dozier

In the name of God Amen I Calit Dozier of the County of
 Camden and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and
 Memory blessed be God do this tenth day of March in the year
 of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one make
 and establish this my last will and Testament in manner
 and form as follows - To wit,
 After paying all of my Just debts and burial expenses my will
 is that Money and promissory notes that shall be left on hand
 belonging to me at my death be divided into three Equal portions
 and then each one of said portions to be subdivided and appropriated
 by my Executor in manner as shall hereafter be specified -
 I then one of the above named portions I leave to be divided as follows first
 I give and bequeath out of said portion unto my Grand son
 Samuel Williams One hundred dollars secondly I give and

Bequeath unto my grand son Caleb Williams one other hundred dollars of said portion, and lend the use of one other hundred dollars out of said portion unto my great Grand son James Coker, and if he departs this life under age and without any lawful issue of his body the my will is that it be divided equally unto my grand son John Williams Samuel Williams Caleb Williams and my grand daughter Chloe Granger, but if said James Coker arrives to the full age of Twenty one years old, or shall have any lawful issue as above stated, then or in either of said cases, I give the afore said sum of one hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever and the balance of the above portion after deducting the above Legacy given away - (herefrom) I give unto my Grand sons John Williams Samuel Williams, Caleb Williams, Chloe Granger and my Great Grandson James Coker, to be divided equally among them share & share alike, & if the said James Coker departs this life under age & without any lawful issue of his body then and in that case I leave his said share, to my grand sons John Williams, Samuel Williams, Caleb Williams, & Chloe Granger my grand daughter, but if the said James Coker arrives to the age of Twenty one years old, or shall have any lawful issue or issues of his body, as above stated then or in either of said cases I give the said share unto him and his heirs forever -

Item one other of said portions afore mentioned I leave to be subdivided and appropriated by my Executor in equal shares unto the persons whose names are as persons to wit: I give and bequeath unto my Grand son Alexander Hastings one of the said shares one other of said shares I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Louisa Bell, one other share I give unto my grand daughter Polly Hastings, one other of said shares I give unto my grand daughter Martha Bell, one other share I give unto my Grand son Josiah Bell, and the other share I give & bequeath unto my Grand son Caleb Bell.

Item The other said portion afore mentioned I leave to be subdivided and appropriated by my Executor in equal shares among the following persons, that is to say, I give & bequeath one of said shares unto my Grand daughter Lydia Phillips, one share I give and bequeath unto my Grand son James Gregory, one other share I give & bequeath unto my Grand son Noah Gregory and the other share I give unto my Grand daughter Fanny Gregory.

And I hereby nominate and appoint my Friends Thomas Dozier & William Sharning Executors to this my last will & Testament acknowledging this to be my last & I also appoint them Guardians to all of the Legates herebefore named that shall or may be under age by their giving bond with approve security as is Required by Law from Guardians of Intestate orphans, in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal, the day & year first above written.
