Shadrach Brite In the name of God Amen I Shadrach Brite of the County  
of Camden and State of North Carolina being of perfect  
sound mind and memory thanks be given unto God for  
the same calling to mind the mortality of my Body &  
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do  
make & ordain this my last will & Testament in manner  
following

First I give & bequeath unto my well beloved son John M  
Brite a certain part of my Land lying on the north  
west end of my plantation being bounded as follows  
beginning at a cypress post on John M Brites line then  
running across my plantation to a cypress on the margin  
of the Swamp marked then still running a straight  
line with the first across my Swamp to the back line  
to Wilson Sandelins line then binding the said Sandelins  
line to the heirs of William Saylor's line then binding  
said heirs line to Amos Saylor's line then binding  
Amos Saylor's line to Miller Mephusons line then binding  
Mephusons line to John M. Brites line then binding said  
John M Brites line to the first Station and all my car  
penters & coopers tools to him & his heirs forever

Second I give & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Elizabeth  
Brite a certain part of my Land being bounded as  
follows beginning at the above mentioned cypress post  
then binding John M Brites line to another cypress post  
then binding John M Brites line across my plantation  
down the center of my Road to a water lake on the  
Swamp marked then running the same course to the  
back line then binding Mephusons & Sandelins line to the  
course of the piece above given then binding said line to  
the first Station on Feather Bed & furniture to him & his  
heirs forever

Third I give & bequeath unto my well beloved daughter Rebecca  
Mephuson a certain part of my Land being bounded  
as follows beginning at Sunpor post on John M. Brites  
line then running across my plantation to an Elm  
in the the margin of the Swamp marked still running  
the same course to my back line to Miller Mephusons line

Shadrach Brite then binding the said Mephusons line to Ira Jones line  
then binding Ira Jones line to John M Brites line then  
binding John M Brites line to the first Station one Feather  
Bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever

Fourth I give and bequeath unto my well beloved daughter  
Lucy Brite the remaining part of my Land that is not  
given away together with all the remaining part of my  
chattles that is not given away to her and her heirs forever  
Also I constitute make & ordain my son John M. Brite  
my whole & sole Executor to this my last will & Testament  
to do according to the legacies bequeathed in witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 16  
day of March 1831

I give and bequeath unto my son Timothy Gardner Chamberlain one third part of my Land say beginning at a corner between betwixt my Lands and Jos Pitchard running a strale line to the corner of Mrs. Mary Smiths here line thence a strale line to a junction line thence to the Mill Swamp Road thence along the said Road to the bed of the main corner thence along my line strale course to said Pitchard line thence along said Pitchard line to the first station Gum also enough of the swamp Land to make one third of all my Lands say on the side adjoining said Smiths line to the Swamp to him & his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my son James Hester Chamberlain all of my Lands that is not already given away also one negro woman by the name of Mornin also all of my property that is not already given away after paying all of my best debts to him & his heirs forever

And I her by nominate & appoint my worthy friend Timothy C. Chamberlain Executor to this my last Will & Testament whome I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written signed sealed published & declared in presence of us who were present at the time of signing sealing them of

I Give and bequeath unto Jos Dozier & Edward Sanders of Camden all the Land negroes hogs cattle hogs sheep farming utensils & all household and kitchen furniture carts gigs & all other property belonging to me which I have not otherwise conveyed in a deed of Trust to Josiah Dozier & Jos Dozier Trustee which has been duly proven & Registered in Camden County to them & their heirs & ours or so much thereof as may be necessary to secure them from payment of any monies that they may have
