- 4th I give unto beloved mother Polly Cartwright one hundred dollars also my grey mare to her and her heirs forever -
- 5th I give and bequeath unto my brother William Guilford the remainder of my estate both real and personal after paying all my just debts to him and his heirs forever - And I hereby make and ordain my worthy brother and father William Guilford and Sideon Cartwright his executors of this my Last will and Testament, in witness whereof I the said Stephen Guilford have to this my Last will and Testament set my hand and seal the day and year above written

3rd All the residue of my property not already given away I wish be equally divided between my daughter Amy Samell & my son Elias Williams to them & their heirs for ever -

4th I do hereby nominate & appoint my beloved wife Margaret Williams Executor to this my last will & Testament - In Witness whereof I the said Edward Williams do to this my last will & Testament set my hand & seal -
