B. Proctor & Lovy L. Proctor to be Equally divided between them. As to my place called Padmore & my Interest in the Juniper Swamp & all the Remainder of my property whatsoever to my said daughter Ann C. B. Proctor & Lovy L. Proctor and their heirs forever in the event of my said youngest daughter Mary Virginia dying without issue living at the time of her death as before mentioned. Excepting from the aforesaid bequest I desire my two silver Tumblers which I give to my daughter Ann C. B. Proctor and my silver spoons Marked &c to my daughter Lovy Louisa & my other children
