Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Eliza Taylor one Feather Bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever. All the Balance of my Estate not Given away I want Sold for the purpose of paying my Lawful debts.

I hereby nominate and appoint Nelson Cartwright Executor to this my last will and Testament hereby Revoking all Wills or bequeaths here before made in Testimony whereof I have herebefore set my hand and seal this 23rd Jan'y 1832
