In the name of God, Amen, I Annis Sawyer of Caswell County, N.
 Carolina, being sound and perfect mind and memory (blessed be
 God) do this eighth day of August in the year of our Lord Eighteen
 hundred and twenty two make and publish this my Last will
 and Testament in manner following, that is to say.

In the 1st place I give and bequeath to my loving nephew Edmund Sawyer son of
 my brother Abner Sawyer all the land I possess lying between my
 big ditch to Nathaniel Hathaways and bounded by Melicki Sawyer's
 and Ezekiel Sanderlin's line together with the swamp adjoining - Also
 a negro boy named James and negro boy named Jack, one feather
 bed and furniture, Two cows and calves to him and his heirs forever.

Secondly I give and bequeath to my loving nephew Abner Sawyer son of my brother
 Abner, the tract of land that I purchased from Samuel Sanderlin and
 the swamp adjoining, also negro boy Isaac to him and his heirs forever.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my loving and adopted daughter Mary Sawyer
 daughter of Mary Sawyer during her natural life the plan-
 tation on which I reside binding on Mary Sanderlin to Chestnut Oak
 thence across the plantation that I bought of Mark Sawyer to a persim-
 mon tree standing on the line of Joseph Sanderlin's heirs, also the swamp
 adjoining it. One negro man named Sampson a blacksmith with his set of tools
 two negro girls Chloe and Harriet, negro boy Ambros, two feather

beds, and furniture, one curtain instead, during her natural life and
 should she have lawful children some of her body, to them forever, should
 she die without such issue, it then is to go to my loving nephew Edmund
 Sawyer above named to him and his heirs forever.

Fourthly I give and bequeath to my loving niece Charlotte Sawyer daughter of my
 brother Abner Sawyer one negro girl Elizabeth, and a negro boy Harry
 to her and her heirs forever.

Fifthly I do bequeath to my loving niece Elizabeth Sawyer daughter of my
 brother Abner, the emoluments arising from the rents of a tract
 of land that I purchased from Melicki Sawyer binding on Joseph
 Sanderlin's heirs to a Chestnut Oak thence across a plantation that I
 bought of Mark Sawyer to persimmon tree standing on the line
 of Joseph Sanderlin's heirs, and the swamp adjoining during her
 natural life, and at her decease the land to be equally divided
 between her sisters Margaret and Chloe Sawyer to them and their heirs forever.

Sixthly I give and bequeath to my loving niece Margaret Sawyer (above-
 mentioned) daughter of my brother Abner, a negro woman Basiak
 and negro boy Dennis to her and her heirs forever.

Seventhly I give and bequeath to my loving niece Chloe Sawyer daughter
 of my brother Abner Sawyer a negro girl named Patsy to her
 and her heirs forever.

Eighthly I give and bequeath to my loving niece Sally Ann Sawyer daugh-
 ter of my brother Abner Sawyer, all the land that I possess on
 the lake side that I purchased from Ammon Grandy and
 Frederic Grandy, also a negro woman Ester now indentured - negro
 little Sam, brother of Ester and negro boy named Leuben to
 her and to hold her and her heirs forever.

Ninthly I give and bequeath to my loving and adopted son Abner Sawyer
 son of Cliff Sawyer (alias Cliff Gregory) the tract of land where
 he now resides together with three acres adjoining that I bought
 of William Williams and negro man Sam Sawyer to him and his heirs
 forever.

Tenthly I give and bequeath to my loving brother Abner Sawyer, two negro
 old Sam and Pompey together with all and every residue of my
 property both real and personal including chattels and papers
 of every description which I did possess of, not already disposed
 of as above - Out of which I must give him he is to defray
 funeral expenses and lawful debts, The residue to him and

his heirs forever. — And I hereby make and ordain my
worthy friends, Joseph Dozier Esq. and Willoughby D. Barnard
executors of this my last will and Testament hereto now making all
others made by me prior to this date, In witness whereof I the said
Evan Dozier have to this my last will and Testament set my
hand and seal the day and year above written
