the houses annexed during her life - also I give her one of my
horses her choice four Cows & calves her choice three or four chain
harness three feather beds & furniture her choice
Item I give & bequeath unto my two sons Meluan & James Phillips
all my lands after the death or marriage of my wife to be
equally divided between them, to them & their heirs forever -
Item I give unto my daughter Polly Burfoot one negro woman

by the name of affa, one negro woman by the name of Rachel
one negro boy by the name of Harry one negro boy by the name
of Sam, to her & her heirs for ever-

The Wilson B Webster & Hezekiah Wright do certify that we heard Samuel Phelps Esq at the making of the above legacy to his daughter Polly Comfort say that it was as he intended to give her out of his Estate -

 Calf to him & his heirs for ever -
 Fourthly. I leave all the remaining Part of my property with all
 the remaining part of my mother's estate in the hands of
 Francis Davis to my two sons above named after paying my
 Just debts I shall & shall alike to them & their heirs for ever -
 Lastly I nominate & appoint my friend Ira McPherson
 Executor to this my last will & Testament to do according
 to the legacies bequeathed - In witness I have hereunto
 set my hand & seal this 21. May 1825.

 God, calling to mind the certainty of Death & the
 uncertainty of the time thereof, do make & establish & ordain
 this my last will & Testament this the 23. day of
 September Anno Dom. 1822 - in manner & form following
 that is to say -

I give & devise all my Lands which I have purchased from
 any person to my children to be equally divided between
 them I shall & shall alike - also all the land Down in Gates
 County, to them & their heirs for ever

I give & bequeath unto the widow of my brother William
 Trotman all his estate which I have except one negro
 man by the name of Cass which I reserve for the use of my
 estate -

I give & bequeath unto my nephew Alfred Trotman one horse
 Colt, known by the name of Staples Colt, also one negro boy by the
 name of Sampson, to him & his heirs for ever.

I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Emilia and my children
 all the rest of my negroes to be equally divided between them
 I shall & shall alike when my oldest child arrives to lawful
 age or marries to them & their heirs for ever

All the remainder of my estate which I have not already
 given away I leave to be sold by my executor here after
 mentioned & after paying all my Just debts the residue
 if any to be equally divided between my wife & children I shall
