I give and bequeath unto my six Daughters to be Equally Divided between the heirs that are living and the children of them that are dead viz Each Daughter children to his three mothers I hear these are the heirs hereafter named that are living Margaret Forbes Mary Gallop Batsheba Forbes these are the Daughters that are dead that is to say Abigail Hunings Sarah Whitehall Mariam Right to them and their heirs

Last of all I recommend and appoint my faithful and Trusty Friend & Trusty Friend to be my whole and Sole Executor of this my last will and Testament and I the said Henry Bray do disannul all former Wills & Testaments and do Ratify and confirm this to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 30th day of June in the year of our Lord 1833.
