of Camden & State of North Carolina of perfect, sound, disposing mind
and memory do make this my last will & Testament in the following manner
to wit.

Item 1. I leave to my beloved wife Elizabeth as long as she lives my and the use of
fifteen thousand corn hills adjoining the houses - also I give to my wife Elizabeth
one Bed & furniture, one linen wheel to her and her heirs forever

Item 2. I give devise & bequeath to my son Almond Brito a certain tract or piece of land
containing twenty five acres more or less according to the following bounds beginning
at a Red oak a corner two in the New Ferry then running down a branch
to William Jones' line then along then line to Spencer's line, then along
Spencer's line to the line of a piece sold to Sipe Easton then binding the same
to Anney Rhodes line then binding Anney Rhodes line to the first station
to him and his heirs forever

Item 3. I give devise & bequeath to my son Malachi Brito a certain piece of Land
Containing fifteen acres more or less according to the following bounds - Beginning
in the road at the Gap then running along the Causeway or road leading
to the house to the Corner of the Cyder Reef then a straight course to an old
Sycamore stump, then running down the old to the end thereof & thence
Southwesterly to an Elm near the corner of the Island tract then binding from
old ditch to Causeway or Big ditch then Binding the big ditch to Anney
Rhodes line to the road then binding road to the first station to him &
his heirs forever

Item 4. I give devise & bequeath to my son Silas Brito a certain piece of land
lying over the road called the old wheat patch tract, according to the
following bounds. Beginning in Anna Rhodes line at the three corner
Beaches then binding Anna Rhodes line to the Road then along the
road to John Jones line then along his line to the first station
Beaches to him & his heirs forever

Item 5. I give devise & bequeath to my son Charles Brito all my Personal estate
of every description within doors or without that I may be possessed of at the
time of my death, after paying all my just debts to him and his heirs
forever

Item 6. I give devise & bequeath to my Sons Malachi & Silas Brito a small strip
of land lying between the three corner beaches & the Red oak (being
all the balance of my lands) to be equally divided between the two, to
them & their heirs forever

Item 7. It is my will & desire that my son Almond Brito should have

ditch & Big ditch which will make a good most convenient for the purpose of draining
his lands.

I nominate & appoint George Oriskany Executor to this my last will & Testament
nothing else other my & Bequeathments hereafter made. In Testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th day of January Anno Dom. 1820.

sound and perfect mind and memory thank be to almighty god for it do this
5th day of April in the year one thousand eight hundred & twenty two, make, ordain, con-
-stitute and appoint this my last will & Testament in manner and form as follows

Last of all I make ordain and appoint my beloved wife Sally Fenwick
and living son William Fenwick Executors to this my last will & Testament.
