In the of God I Isaac Harrison son of the County
of Camden and State of North Carolina on the 10th day
of Feby - 4. 1834. Being in a low state of health
though of sound mind & memory thank be given to
God for the same to make publish & Ordain this my last
Will & Testament in respect of my worldly estate that it hath
pleased God to bless me with First of all I Recommend
my soul to God who gave it me & my Body to be buried
in a Christian like manner

I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Lidea Harrison
two & a half Bells of iron one horse Buda & saddle

one Horse Cart & Harness one Blanket & Harness two
Skins Head of Hags 1 pair Fire Dogs one Table one pair shoes
one pair Iron mule one Gun with four chairs one Bedstead one chest
one Loom & Harness one Dutch oven one Tea Kettle one Skillet
the Dautry in the plantation fifty Bunches of corn fifty Bunches
of wheat fifty Bunches of Sweet Potatoes Also an negro man
named Ichabod and I also find his one one negro Girl
Lenny during his natural life & at my wife's death for the said
negro Girl Lenny to be Equally divided between my four Daugh-
ters viz Mary Lydia Sarah & Martha. I also find the use
of the following Land to my beloved wife Lidea Harrison during
his natural life viz Beginning on the main Road near the old shop
thence a westerly course to the woods on the wharf Road thence
along the woods fence a southwesterly course by a neck of cleared
Land that leads to my Martin Wright place thence along the
fence various course to the main Road thence along the said Road
to the first Station containing all the cleared Land of the plantation
whereon I now live next said main Road with the Buildings
thereon with the privilege of fire & wood & Rail Timber from my
wood Land

I give and bequeath unto my son Morgan Harrison all the
Lands which I bought of Thomas Roberts up to a ditch
that runs from Live Wrights without line the first ditch upon the
South Side of a Dungle whereon Martin Wright formerly lived
and runs an easterly course as the ditch runs until it strikes
the line of the heirs of Seth Will and then runs easterly of
the main Road which I bought of Matthias Sawyer also one
negro Boy by the name of Matthias to him & his heirs forever
Reserving the Land which I left to my wife during her natural
life

I give & bequeath to my son Wilson Harrison all the Land
which I own on the easterly side of the main Road it
being bought of Isaac Gufford Jacob Goffey and Samuel
Bray wife and fifty acres of Swamp that was sold to me
by John Seymour also one negro Boy named Amos to him and
his heirs forever

I find to my Grand Daughter Peggy Harrison my River side
Land & Plantation to be Rented out for her until she arrives

Isaac Harrison to the age of Twenty one Years then if Living I give & bequeath the said Plantation to him & his Heirs forever. But if dead to Return to my estate as it now stands.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Guilford Harrison my Plantation lying on an Indian Swamp together with Twenty Acres of Swamp Land adjoining the aforesaid land also thirty one acres of Land lying on Burlington Road and a piece of Swamp Land held by a Deed from Edward Faircloth the above twenty acres of Swamp land was bought by me of Cason Morissette to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my Grand sons Benjamin Gregory Noah Gregory and Samuel Gregory and of my Grand Son Isaac Gregory all that tract of Land that I bought of Robert Harrison containing fifty acres more or less to them and their Heirs forever provided they Release me & my Estate from the suretyship of my son Benjamin Harrison for the Guardian Bond of Thomas Gregory heir of the said Gregorys Heirs will not Release me & my Estate from the said suretyship then my will is that the said Land shall be sold and the said surety debt paid out of the proceeds of said land & if there are any over after paying the same that it be paid over to them equally.

Item I give & bequeath to the children of my Grand Daughter Rishah Barnard one hundred Dollars each.

Item I Give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin D. Harrison one hundred Dollars to him & his Heirs forever.

Item I Give and Bequeath to my Grand Son Isaac Harrison one hundred Dollars.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter Nancy Gray one Dollar with what I have already given her to her and her Heirs forever.

Item I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Harrison the Land which I bought from the estate of Peter Harrison dead together with the balance of the tract that I bought of Thomas Roberts not before given away to her & her Heirs forever. And the Land I value at four hundred Dollars the valuation of said Land is to be taken out of the amount of property which I leave to my four Daughters viz or the said Mary Harrison's part.

Item I Give & bequeath to my Daughter Lydia Harrison all of the Land and Plantation which was formerly my Father laying on the Southwest side of the Main Road near Road to her and her Heirs forever which I value at seven hundred Dollars and the valuation of said plantation is to be taken out of the amount of property which I leave to my four Daughters or the said Lydia Harrison's part.

Item I Give & bequeath to my four Daughters viz Mary Harrison Lydia Harrison Sarah Harrison & Martha Harrison my negroes and all the rest of my property both within doors & without doors not before given away for each one to have an equal proportion of the same & including the Legacy of the said Mary & the said Lydia or the valuation of the same to be added to the Balance & then Equally divided between my four Daughters so that each one will have an equal proportion of the whole.

Item Lastly of all I constitute make & appoint Joseph G. Hughes and my son Guilford Harrison my whole & sole Executors to this my last Will and Testament intending Revoking & disannulling all others by me made in any wise Ratifying confirming and acknowledging this to be my last Will & Testament in witness I do hereunto set my hand and seal the day and date above written Signed sealed & acknowledged
