that she also can spare with all the Lumber that is on
hand to be sold by my Executors & the Proceeds of the sale
thunof to be applied by my said Executors to the paying
of my Debts also all the notes & money that shall be
left on hand

And I hereby appoint and nominate my worthy friends
Wilson G. Lamb & John D. Grandy and my beloved wife
Mary Dager Executors & Executrix to this my last Will
& Testament and I hereby authorize and empower them
to sell the property of my estate set apart in the Body
of this my last Will & Testament for that Purpose either
at Private Sale or Public as they may deem most
expedient In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and Seal to this my last Will & Testament
Acknowledging this to be my last the day & date first

In the Name of God Amen I John Kenaday of the County
of Camden & State of S. Carolina being a perfect Sane
Mind & knowing that I am going to die I do make and publish this
to be my last will & Testament disavowing all others
Wills & Gifts heretofore by me made & given & dispose
in manner and form as follows

in the first place I lend the use of one third part of the man
w. Plantation & Land whereon I now live unto my dearly beloved
wife Lydia Kenaday for natural life or widowhood only
reserving a small piece that I cut off by a line from a
Black Gum to a Holly Tree containing about three or four
acres for the use of Isaac Jones whereon she now lives
also I lend the use of one Leather Bed & Furniture her share
ice one Wheel & one pr of Dog Irons & Traps her natural life
or widowhood & sufficient Support for one year & family
I give & bequeath unto my dearly beloved Son William
Kenaday all that Tract or piece of Land whereon I now
live & only three or four acres that I cut off as above
stated from the Black Gum to the Holly Tree that I lent
to Isaac Jones then after the death or marriage of my wife
Lydia Kenaday then the whole unto the said William Kenaday
also the Leather Bed & Furniture one pr Dog Irons & Traps that
I lent to my wife unto him & his heirs forever
I give & bequeath unto my dearly beloved daughter Lydia Kenaday all
that piece or Tract of Land lying in swamp containing about

John Knady fifty acres more or less also all the the cattle that on
 hand at my death & one Sowing wheel to his son, then from
 I lend the use of a small piece of Land I cut off by a
 line from a black line to a holly tree containing about
 five or six acres unto my daughter Dorcas Jones whereon
 she now lives her natural life & after her death it gives &
 bequeath the afore Land that I lent unto my daughter
 Dorcas Jones unto my Grand son John Jones to
 him & his heirs forever

It is further my Will that the residue of my estate should
 be sold on a credit of six or twelve months & then after
 paying all my Just debts & lawful expenses the balance
 to be Equally divided between my daughters that are
 living at the time that my Estate is settled

Last of all I appoint and denominate my Faithful &
 Trusty Friend Silas Forbes to be my sole & sole Executor
 this 16th day of October in the year of our Lord 1834

 in Schooling of the Boy & to keep the Boy clear of expence
 only when he goes to School
