I hereby nominate constitute make & appoint my daughter Mary Parker Executrix & my friend Nathaniel Hathaway Executor to this my last will & testament revoking all & every other will or wills may be made. I acknowledge this & this only to be my last. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August anno one thousand eight hundred & twenty seven.

In the name of God Amen! I Joseph Chamblain of the County of Camden & State of North Carolina being very sick & weak but of sound disposing mind & memory thanks be to God - and calling to mind that it was once appointed for man to die. I recommend my body to be buried and my soul to almighty God who gave it - And dispose of worldly effects in the following manner - to wit -

Item 1. I leave to my loving wife during her natural life the use of all my lands & Houses - House & Kitchen furniture - including all my beds & furniture - (except one) all my farming utensils one riding chair & harness, six cows & calves, all the hogs, sheep, & Pigs (except one stick) the old horse & mare, all my tools, hoes & harness, all the corn, pork, oats, wheat, & fodder, flax, wool,

Potatoes, Honey, Sugar, lard, Dish, clock, handmill, carts, wooden ware of all kinds. Fat tubs & Honey tubs - meatstanes, Bannets - Provided nevertheless and upon this condition that my wife will support & maintain my five youngest children until the two youngest children shall arrive to the age of eighteen years - Also the use of negroe woman Rachel & her increase during the same period -

Item 2. I give and devise to my son Simosby C Chamblain one feather bed & furniture one cow & calves one stock of bees & him & his heirs for ever -

Item 3. I give and devise to my son Charles Chamblain one young mare the one half of my carpenters & turning tools & him & his heirs for ever -

Item 4. I give and devise to my son Geo Chamblain Chamberlain one colt democrat, the other half of my carpenters and turning tools to him and his heirs for ever -

Item 5. I give and devise to my daughter Jenny Chamblain one feather bed & furniture one Bureau & one chest to her and her heirs for ever to take possession after the death of her mother unless my wife chooses to give possession earlier -

Item 6. I give and devise to my daughter Sally Chamblain one feather bed & furniture the largest walnut table and one chest to her and her heirs for ever to take possession after mother's death unless her mother chooses to give possession earlier -

Item 7. I give and devise to my daughter Hannah Chamblain one feather bed & furniture one small walnut table to her & her heirs for ever to take possession after the death of her mother unless her mother chooses to give possession earlier -

Item 8. I give & devise to my daughter Mariam Chamblain one bed & furniture one desk one table with a poplar frame & walnut leaf to her & her heirs for ever to take possession after the death of her mother unless she chooses to give possession earlier -

Item 9. I give & devise to my daughter Nancy Chamblain one bed & furniture and one trunk to her & her heirs for ever to take possession after her mother's death -

Item 10. I give & devise to my daughter Harriett Chamblain one bed & furniture one candle stand & to her heirs for ever after her mother's death -

Item 11. I give and devise and bequeath unto my son Cartwright Chamblain all that part of Land lying on the north side of the main road adjoining the lands of John Whitcomb making the road the dwelling line to him & his heirs forever to take possession after his mothers death.

Item 12. I give devise and bequeath to my son Nelson Chamblain the South east end of my plantation adjoining the lands of James C. Smith - Beginning at the mouth of a large ditch on the swamp side of the plantation then running along said ditch until you come to the fork of the ditch - then taking the left hand fork or prong of said ditch and continuing the same to James C. Smith's line binding his line round the land and swamp until a west corner mill stake to place of beginning so as to include all the lands & swamp from said ditch towards Smith's to him his heirs forever to take possession after his mothers death.

Item 13. I give the bequeath to my son Henry Chamblain all the remainder of my plantation & Slaves including all the remainder of the swamp also one clock to him his heirs forever to take possession after the death of his mother.

Item 14. I give & devise to my sons Nelson & Henry Chamblain my Sun but it is my wish and desire that they keep her in the family for the use thereof - and it is also my will and desire that if either of my sons Nelson & Henry should die without lawful issue that the survivor should inherit the land & that are devised to him - to them & their heirs forever after the death of their mother.

Item 15. I leave all the residue of my estate not given as above or above thereof left to my wife during her life to be sold by my Executors at a credit of six months for the purpose of paying my debts - also negroes to be hired out for five years for the purpose of helping to pay my debts - and at the expiration of the term of five years I give & devise to my two sons Charles and John Chamblain the said negroes - But in case the sales of my property & the hire of negroes should be insufficient to pay my debts in that case I leave negroes to be sold by my Executors to pay the balance due and residue of the money arising from the sales of what if any there be, I give to my two sons Charles and John

Chamblain to be equally divided between them - to them & their heirs - I leave my woman Rachel and her increase whatever she be living at the time of my wife's death to be equally divided between all my daughters to them and their heirs forever - and residue of my property the use of which is left to my wife during her life and not already disposed of to be equally between all my daughters also to them & heirs - I hereby nominate and appoint my son Timothy C. Chamblain Executor to this my last will & testament revoking all others heretofore made - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 16 day of October 1824.

In the name of God Amen! I Sarah Perry of Camden County & State of North Carolina do make & ordain this my last will and testament in manner & form following. Namely - I give and bequeath to my son Abner Perry a lot of land beginning at Enck Dailys stand thence along the road westerly to a cedar thence down a ditch southerly to Bailey & Barco's land. To Timothy Perry I give & bequeath the Balance of my cleared land - My woodland I equally divide between my two sons Abner and Timothy - To my daughter Sally I give & bequeath one bed & furniture - I give & bequeath to my daughter Polly one bed & furniture for her to have her choice out of the two the residue to be sold and my just debts paid the rest I give & bequeath one third to my daughter Sally one third to my daughter Polly & one third to my daughter Polly's heirs - I nominate, constitute and appoint my two sons Timothy and Abner sole Executors of this
