Item. I give & bequeath to my daughter Susan Sawyer one bed & furniture one wheel, one cow & calf to her & her heirs for ever.

I appoint John Sawyer & Ammon Brite Executors to this my last will & testament revoking all other wills heretofore made. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal 23rd day of February in the year of our Lord 1820.

I give & bequeath unto my dear beloved daughter Mary Parker one half of my land and the taster beeter and the first choice of the beds & furniture first choice of the linen wheel loom & harness - my silver tea spoons, six red chairs one cow and calf if my daughter Mary should die without a living heir of her body for it to go to dear beloved daughter Sally Parker and her heirs for ever.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my dear beloved daughter Sally Parker one half of my land, one bed & furniture and one cow & calf if my daughter Sally should die without living heir of her body to my daughter Mary if living and her heirs for ever.

Item. I give & bequeath unto my dear wife Peggy all the property that got by her and such panels of corn and three hundred weight of pork one cow and one sow to her & her heirs for ever.
