Isaac Gallop In the name of God Amen I Isaac Gallop son of
 the County of Camden and State of North Carolina
 being of sound & disposing mind & memory blessed
 be God & calling to mind the certainty of death and
 the uncertainty of the time when it will come & being
 willing to dispose of my worldly substance that
 it has pleased God to give me At my own will and
 desire do this fifth day of July one thousand eight
 hundred & thirty three make & ordain this my last
 will & Testament (revoking all others) in the following
 manner viz I bequeath unto my beloved wife Agilpha

Gallop for and during her natural Life or widowhood the use of the following piece of Land lying near Liba Forbet on Sandersons Swamp & bulled & bounded as follows: Beginning at the corner of the piece next to Ryba Lobs near the Swamp thence a Sauthwenty Course along the out Side of the piece to a Cross fence that runs across the plantation thence along said cross fence across the plantation to the Branch thence along said Branch and Swamp to the first Station with the privilege of getting pine wood & rail Timber to support the same off of any of my Lands on that Side of the main Road

Item I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Gilpha Gallop one Leather bed & furniture one Chest one linen wheel in choice one cow & calf two Sheep two Hogs four Chairs one Table one Iron pot one pair of pot hooks and one pot Trammel all her Choice & as much of the crockeryware on hand as she wants and the Sum of two Hundred Dollars to be paid to her by my Executor herein after named out of the Sales of the Surplus of my estate if there should be a Sufficiency if not as far as it will go towards it & should there be a deficiency my Will is that my Executor shall hire out my negroes men Malachi and Mark untill the hire shall amount to said Sum I also give her one years provisions to be set off to her by Commissioners one to be chosen by her and one by my Executor & the two when chosen to have power to choose a third person should they not agree to her and her heirs forever

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Josiah Gallop my negro man Mark to him & his heirs forever making the residue herein before made

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Josiah Gallop all my Land on that Side of the main Road whome I now lease to him & his heirs forever if he shall have heirs living at the time of his death if not I give & bequeath the said Land after his death to my daughter Phoebe Spry and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son Josiah Gallop the Sum of Twenty dollars to him & his heirs forever
 Item I give and bequeath unto Luke G. Lamb in Trust for the use of my daughter Phoebe Spry my plantation which I bought of John Jones esq and my negro man Malachi to be held in Trust by the said Luke G. Lamb for my said daughter Phoebe Spry for and during the life of her husband Samuel Spry & the rents and hire of said Land & negro to be applied by said Luke G. Lamb to the use of my said daughter and her children at his discretion & at the death of Samuel Spry my will is that the said Luke G. Lamb shall convey said Land & negro to my daughter & her heirs forever but if she should not be living herself or have children living my Will is that said Land & negro be conveyed to my son Josiah Gallop & his heirs forever

Item I leave the residue of my Estate not already given away to be sold by my Executor on a credit of six months

And lastly I nominate & appoint my friend Luke G. Lamb Executor to this my last Will & Testament acknowledging this & this only to be my true last Will & Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & date first above written
