the County of Camden and State of North Carolina
being weak of Body but of perfect sound
Mind & Memory calling to mind the mortality
of my Body knowing it is appointed for
all men once to die in the first place I
Recommend my body to the Grave to be
buried in a decent Christian burial & my soul
to God that gave it as touching my worldly
Estate I give and bequeath in the following
manner

to him and his heirs

Then

I give and bequeath unto my last wife childr
in as follows one feather Bed and its mixture one
paler Bason one pair of Fire Dogs one spinning wheel
one iron Tea Kettle one coffee Mill and chest this
I give unto my last wife Mary Brays children
and Grand children that she had before I married
her

Then the rest of my Estate I give and bequeath in
the following manner. I give and bequeath unto my
six Daughters to be Equily divided between the heirs
that's living and the children of them that are dead
By Each Daughters children to his three mothers
I hear these are the heirs hereafter named that are
living Margaret Torrey Mary Gallop Batsheba
Forbes these are the Daughters that are dead that is
to say Abigail Hunings Sarah Whitehall Mariam
Right to them and their heirs

Last of all I recommend and appoint my faithful
and Trusty Friend Isaac Torrey to be my whole
and Sole Executor of this my Last will and Testament
and I the said Henry Bray do disanull all former
Wills & Testaments and do Ratify and confirm this to be
my last will and Testament in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 30th day
of June in the year of our Lord 1833.
