and if either of them should depart this life under age
or without leaving any lawful Issue then my Will is
that the surviving one shall inherit all and I give unto
my said Stepson Wilson G. Lamb all of the Lumper and
Cypress Swamp that I Purchased from the Heirs of
Wicks Grandy dead and I also give the Cypress Swamp
adjoining the land of Haywood S. Bell & others which
part or share thereof that I am entitled to unto my Step
son Gideon Lamb upon this proviso that my Executors
shall have full power and Authority if need be for want
of a Sufficiency of other property to pay all of my Just
Debts that is belonging to my estate to sell any of the
above Legacies or parts thereof as they may choose for
the purpose of paying my said Debts

I give unto my two nephews Andrew S. Dozier and
James Grandy one negro man named David & if either
shall depart this life under age and without leaving
any lawful Issue then & in that case I give said negro
David of on said unto the one that shall survive the other

I leave the Land I purchased from Wicks Cooper to be sold
by my Executors in case there is not enough property belong-
ing to my estate to pay my Just Debts not given away in
the body of this Will the House hold and Kitchen furniture
excepted & the residue of the proceed of the Sale thereof
after paying the balance of said debts if there shall be
any such balance wanting I give the said Residue of
the Sales of said Tract of Land of on said if any then be
unto my two nephews of on said Andrew S. Dozier and
James Grandy to be Equally divided between them share
and share alike & if either of them depart this life without
leaving any lawful Issue then my will is that the sur-
viving one shall inherit the others said share

My Will also is that if there shall be property enough belong-
ing to my estate not already given away in the body
of this Will to satisfy & pay all my Just Debts without
the above described Land that I purchased from said
Wicks Cooper of on said then I give the said tract
