acres of which I bought of Arthur Gregory formerly
owned by William Wright to her & her heirs forever
also one feather Bed & Furniture & one large Chest

I give & bequeath unto my dear Brother Enoch Sawyer
three & a half acres of Land lying & being in the neck
which is my part of the Land which formerly belonged
to my Father Enoch Sawyer and to him & to his heirs
forever also some flowering Plank which is at house &c
also one feather Bed & Furniture to him & his heirs forever
also one small Trunk to him &c

And then it is further my will that all of the remainder
of my property to be sold on a credit both Land &
moveables within doors & without all with the exception
of what has been hitherto given away and out of the
funds arising from said sale all of my just debts to
be paid then it is my will for my dear Brother Enoch
Sawyer to have the ballance to him & his heirs forever

And last of all I appoint & nominate my faithful
trustworthy friend Stephen Corcor to be my whole and
sole Executor this 2 day of April in the Year of our
Lord 1833.
