of Camden & State of North Carolina being of perfect
Sound Mind & Memory thanks be given unto God Calling
unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die I do make and
Publish this my last Will & Testament disallowing
all other Wills heretofore by me made I give & dispose
in the manner & form as follows this 10 day of April in
the year of our Lord 1830.

& plantation whereon I now live Negroes Mules Three feather
Beds & Furniture her choice one horse & Riding Chaise one
Beaver & Clock one Breakfast all the furniture that
belong in the said Breakfast on the 1st Beauson, Two
Cows & Calves her choice Six head of Sheep Two Tables her
choice one Day Chaise her choice Two chest her choice
1 Day Silver Spoons Its further than my will that I give
unto my dearly beloved wife Jane Gregory one Negro woman
by the name of Vittel also then as much of my Crop &
provisions that on hand at my death as my Executors
think proper for her support and Six head of Hogs her
choice to her & her heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto Sarah Laughinghouse one negro
girl by the name of Miriam to her & her heirs forever

Item

I give & bequeath unto Margaret Stephens one negro
Boy by the name of Thomas to her & her heirs forever

Item

I give & bequeath unto Polly Forbes one feather
Bed & furniture to her & her heirs forever

Its further than my Will that I lend the use of my Land
whereon Evan Forbes now live unto his wife Polly Forbes
untill Death or marriage & no longer & after her death or
marriage I give & bequeath unto Isaac Forbes the son

Item I give & bequeath unto Noah Stephens all that tract
of Land lying South of the main Road that I bought of
David Gregory Jonathan Gregory & Absalom Gregory to
him and his heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto John Burfoot all them two tracts
of Land that Adam Burgess & Thelton Bells now live on ag-
owning the Lands belonging to the heirs of Demsey Dagers
Dells & the heirs of Caleb Williams died to him & his heirs
forever

I give & bequeath unto Lury Sawyer all that tract of Land
whereon Zachariah Right now live only the use of the
said Land Reserved untill the death of the said Zachariah
Right & wife & after their death to him & his heirs forever
Its further than my Will that I lend the use of my Land and
plantation whereon I now live after the death of my wife
Jane Gregory unto B. Shubert morell her natural life
and if she shall have any children then I give it unto
them and if none I give unto Peter Forbes & Evan Forbes
the sons of Evan Forbes to them & their heirs forever

I give & bequeath unto Thelton Burfoot that tract or piece
of Island Land that I bought of John Mitchell containing
by estimation fifty acres and fifty of Swamps lying on
the North River to him & his heirs forever

Item

I give & bequeath unto William B. Gregory that tract of
Island land I bought of Silas Bells containing by
Estimation fifty acres be it the same more or less also fifty
acres of Swamp land lying on the North River to him &
his heirs forever Its further than my will that after paying
all my Just debts & Lawful expenses that the residue of my estate
not given off be sold on a Credit of Twelve months & equally
divided between my wife Jane Gregory & Elizabeth Laughinghouse
use Margaret Forbes to them & their heirs forever

Last of all I appoint my faithful & Trusty friend Silas Forbes
to be my whole & Sole Executor the day & date first above written

Curry one Negro Boy by the name of Bert to him & his heirs
forever The balance of my estate that is not given a
way I leave to be sold by my Executors after paying my
Just debts to be Equally divided Share & Share alike between
all my heirs at Law

I further more nominate my friend Cornelius G. Lamb
as Executor to this my last Will & Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal the any date above written

make & publish this my last Will & Testament in the follow
ing manner to wit

First to my beloved wife Polly Dyer I leave the use of my plan
tation whereon I now live during her life with privilege to cut
wood get rails or any other kind of Lumber from off the Lake
Land I bought of John Dabney

I further lend to my said wife Polly one Negro Mary Morica
during her widowhood & at her death or marriage said Negro
to be sold five days notice being given & the proceeds arising
from said sale to be Equally divided between Haman D. Bee
& Chloa Humphris daughter of John Humphris & wife
Charity

I further give & bequeath unto my said wife Polly the follow
ing Negroes to wit Labisha Lydia Eady Mason & Horatio
to her & her heirs forever

I leave the use of one half of the Tract of Land that I bought
of John D. Dyer in the Lake to Haman D. Bee and
if said Haman should die without a Lawful heir begotten
of his Body said Land to fall to Samuel Humphris Son of John
and Charity & thence to him & his heirs forever

I further leave to said Haman D. Bee a certain piece of Swamp
Land of 52 acres that formerly belong to John Dyer and if said
Haman should die without an heir Lawfully begotten of his
