

Mrs. Fanny Hemmington In the name of God Amen! I Fanny Hemmington of Camden County being of sound and perfect mind & memory (I thank God) do this 15th day of March in the year of our Lord 1828, make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner following, that to wit:-

First- I give my son Sammon Hemmington five shillings - Item I give my son Thomas Hemmington five shillings and it is my desire & will all the remaining part of my property at my death after paying my just debts should be equally divided between my three children now with me namely Mary Hemmington, Daniel Hemmington & William Hemmington to be appraised & divided equally - and I hereby make and ordain my loving son Daniel Hemmington Executor of this my last Will & Testament in witness whereof I the said Fanny Hemmington have to this my last Will & Testament set my hand & seal the day & year above written -

Amen I Polly Lacey of the County of Camden & State of North Carolina being in a very low state of health but of sound mind & memory but the certainty of death and uncertainty of life do make this my last Will and Testament this the 25 day of December in the year of our Lord 1828.

- Item- I give the bequest unto my sister Sally Lacey one linen cloth to have her heirs for ever -
- Item- I give the bequest unto my sister Nancy Lacey one looking glass to have her heirs for ever -
- Item- I give the bequest to my sister Julia Lacey one chest to have and her heirs for ever -
- Item- I give the bequest unto my sister Peggy Lacey one negro girl Leticia to have & her heirs for ever -
- Item- I give the bequest unto my brother John Lacey thirty dollars out of my estate for the purpose of schooling &c.

Polly Lacey's Will

I give & bequeath unto Polly Gregory the wife of Job Gregory five dollars - I give & bequeath unto Ann Lacey my mother in law after paying all my just debts of any the residue of my estate - I also nominate and appoint my friend Mark Gregory my Executor to this my last Will & Testament Given under my hand & seal.

Will. Isaac Fanchosh In the name of God Amen. I Isaac Fanchosh of the County of Camden & State of North Carolina being weak in body but of perfect sound mind and memory thanks be given unto God - Calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die I do make and ordain this to be my last Will & Testament disannulling and revoking all other wills and Gifts heretofore by me made - I give and dispose in following manner -

- Item- I lend unto my dearly beloved wife Rosamond Fanchosh the use of all my lands & tenements together with all my stock hewn household & kitchen furniture within & out doors only reserving enough for to be sold on account of six months for to pay all my just debts & lawful expenses then the residue to her for natural life -
- Item- It is further my will that after the death of my dearly beloved wife Rosamond Fanchosh that all my estate lands & tenements be sold on account of six months and be equally divided between my sisters Elizabeth Fanchosh to have one fifth part - Rebecca Gilbert to have one fifth part - my brother Edward Fanchosh's children to have one fifth part - my sister Sarah Pats children to have one fifth part - and my sister Abigail Williams' daughter Pontianica Bray to have one fifth part to have & their heirs for ever -
- Last of all I appoint & denominate my faithful and trusty friend Elias Corbett to be my whole & sole Executor this 9 day of April in the year of our Lord 1829.
