Item 1. I give and bequeath to my well Beloved Cousin Rebecca Orenton, one linen wheel and one chest and all my cloths, one flock and Coad excepted which I give to my Cousin Margaret Taylor daughter of John Taylor to them and their heirs for ever.

Item 2. I give and bequeath to my well belovd Cousin William Taylor all the rest of my property within door and without that is not given away to him and his heirs for ever. Also I do constitute make and ordain William Taylor to be my whole and sole Executor to this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disavow revoke and annul

all and every other former testament, will legacies, Bequeaths, Executors by me in any wise before named made or Bequeathed ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will and testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 8 february 1824
