I lend the use of a small piece of Land I cut off by a
line from a black Gum to a holly tree containing about
two or four acres unto my Daughter Darcas Jones whereon
she now lives her natural life & after her death I give &
bequeath the afore Land that I lent unto my Daughter
Darcas Jones unto my Grand Son John Jones to
him & His Heirs forever

It is further my Will that the residue of my estate should
be sold on a credit of six or twelve months & then after
paying all my Just Debts & Lawful Expenses the balance
to be equally divided between my Daughters that are
living at the time that my estate is settled

Last of all I appoint and denominate my Faithful &
Trusty Friend Silas Forbes to be my sole & sole Executor
this 16th day of October in the year of our Lord 1834

elin all of my Land where I now live also Silas

Clark & Chloey & all the Remainder of my property both
Real & personal after paying my Just debts

Thirdly I give five hundred Dollars to John D. Jones to be exp-
ended on the education of John D. Jones & that I leave
J. S. Sandelin his Guardian & to lay the above amount
in Schooling of the Boy & to keep the Boy clear of expense
only when he goes to School

And I hereby make & ordain my worthy Brother Isaac S.
Sandelin Executor of this my last Will & Testament in writings
whereof I the said W. S. Sandelin have to this my last Will
& Testament Set my hand & Seal the day & year above written
