and memory and knowing it is appointed for all men and women
once to die, do make and publish this my last will and testament
before my departure from this life in manner and form following.
First of all I recommend my body to the dust from whence it
also to be buried in a Christian like manner, and my soul,
who gave it, and after my death I will and desire that the same
be made of all my property both real and personal so much
as are now in my possession as that which I have never had in
my possession, and all which may ever be coming to me by sale
at publick sale with six months credit, for the benefit and use
of my three children, Sally, Sarah a m Williams, who are
illegitimate children of my body, and who I desire may have
my small portion of worldly property after my death.

I also hereby nominate and appoint my friend Bridger
Arendell and my daughter Sally my executors to execute
this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former
wills by me made, and do now deliver this my last will and
testament. This 10th day of April in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and fourteen.

State of North Carolina: In the name of god amen I Isaac Meadow
of Craven County and State aforesaid being of sound mind and memory
doth make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner following:
First I command my wife Mary Meadow by name and place where
I now live in Land with all privileges for plantation use and to
gather and all by plantation tools and household and kitchen furniture
where all my stock of cattle hogs and sheep during her natural life
or widowhood are after her death or marriage allotted to her
next property to Decent unto my two daughters both are now dead
own to be equally divided between them both and given by my wife
Death or marriage I give and Bequeat unto my daughter Elizabeth
all my land and privileges her to holding continue of her Marriage
that running along by the east end of my plantation also I give and Bequeat
unto my Daughter Sarah Meadow all my land and plantation
Westward of the above mentioned bounds with all privileges
there unto belonging.
And I do hereby nominate and appoint John Weeks and my wife Mary
Meadow My sole Executor and Executrix to see my last will and testa-
ment Remaking all other Wills and testaments by me formerly made shall
liking this to be my last will and testament I do hereby Empower my
Executor and Executrix to see as much of my property as will pay all
my just debts and funeral it is my will and desire that all the money
that is due to me be sold or collected or kept at Banks for the use and support of
my wife and family provided it can be set out in good time out from
Security and after my wife Death or marriage the remainder part of my money
to be equally divided between my two aforementioned Daughters and if
either of my daughters should die without an heir a portion of her own property
the property to come by her to Decent to her older Sister. In witness whereof
