Item I will and bequeath that all my debts be paid and Discharged by my Executor and after all my debts is paid and discharged by my Executor also I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Mitty Gillikin of the County and State aforesaid all my Estate to have and to hold to will and to do as she please for the benefit of my small children. During her life or widow hood I also give and bequeath unto all my children five shillings for each child to be paid unto them at their freedom age by my Executors.

Lastly I leave Mitty Gillikin my said wife to be Executor of this my Last will and Testament Hereunto I have set my hand and seal this twentieth ninth day of March in the year of Our Lord 1808

I Chiles Green Being sick and weak of body but of sound perfect sense and memory do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament First I Recommend my Soul to God and my Body to the dust and for what worldly good God has blest me with my will and Desire is that they shall be disposed of in the following manner - Item I give and bequeath unto my Loving Daughter Esther Hataell one old negro woman named Patience to her and her heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mery Green one Fisher Bed and bedstead and all the Furniture belonging to it to her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson James Green Thirteen Acre of land one Fisher Bed all which he has already in Possession to him and his heirs for ever

Item it is my will and Desire that all my cattle that I have after those names are taken out that was given to me by my Husbands will should be Equally divided between my Daughter Esther Hataell and Phoebe Moore and my Grand Daughter Mery Green and my Grandson Jonathan Green that is my 2^d Grand Children both of them to have one share each to one of my Daughters also it is my will and Desire that all the cattle that was given to me by my Husbands will should be Equally divided between all my children to wit Zachus Green Archulus Green Esther Hataell and Phoebe Moore - to them and their heirs for ever.

Item it is my will and Desire that my son Archulus Green should have seven Hundred wt of Pork and fifteen Barrels of Lard for one year support

Item I also give and bequeath unto my 2^d son Archulus Green one small Piece of Land which I got of Toby weers, joining his Plantation, to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath unto my son Zachus Green Two Hundred and Twenty acres of Land on the Great Lake to him and his heirs for ever

Item it is my wish and Desire that after all my just debts is paid that all the Remainder of my Property that is not here mentioned should be divided in the following manner one third to my Daughter Esther Hataell one third to my Daughter Phoebe Moore and the other third unto my two Grand Children Jonathan and Mery Green - to them and their heirs for ever and Lastly I do constitute and appoint my Loving son Zachus Green and William Hataell Executors unto this my Last will
