During her life or widowhood I also give and bequeath unto all my children five shillings for each child to be paid unto them at their freedom age by my Executors.

Lastly I leave Mitty Gillikin my said wife to be Executor of this my Last will and Testament. Hereunto I have set my hand and seal this twentieth ninth day of March in the year of Our Lord 1808.

I Chiles Green Being sick and weak of Body but of sound perfect sense and memory do make and ordain this my Last will and Testament. First I Recommend my Soul to God and my Body to the dust and for what worldly God has blest me with my will and Desire is that they shall be disposed of in the following manner - I leave I give and bequeath unto my Loving Daughters Easter Hatarell one old negro woman named Patience to her and her heirs forever. I leave I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Mitty Green one Fether Bed and bedstead and all the Furniture belonging to it to her and her heirs forever. I leave I give and bequeath unto my Grandson James Freshwaters Thirteen Acre of land one fether Bed and all which he has already in Possession to him and his heirs forever. I leave it is my will and Desire that all my cattle that I have after these names are taken out that was given to me by my Husband's will should be Equally divided between my Daughters Easter Hatarell and Phoebe Moore and my Grand Daughters Mitty Green and my Grandson Jonathan Green so that is my 2^d Grand Children both of them to have one share equal to one of my Daughters also it is my will and Desire that all the cattle that was given to me by my Husband's will should be Equally divided between all my children to wit Zachus Green Archulus Green Easter Hatarell and Phoebe Moore - to them and their heirs forever.

I leave it is my will and Desire that my son Archulus Green should have Seven Hundred wt of Pork and fifteen Barrels of corn for one years support. I leave I also give and bequeath unto my 2^d son Archulus Green one small Piece of Land which I set off Tobey wecks, joining his Plantation, to him and his heirs forever. I leave I give and bequeath unto my son Zachus Green Two Hundred and Twenty acres of Land on the Great Lake to him and his heirs forever. I leave it is my wish and Desire that after all my just debts is paid that all the Remainder of my Property that is not here mentioned should be divided in the following manner one third to my Daughter Easter Hatarell one third to my Daughter Phoebe Moore and the other I give unto my two Grand Children Jonathan and Mitty Green - to them and their heirs forever and lastly I do constitute and appoint my Loving son Zachus Green and William Hatarell Executors unto this my Last will
