Signed sealed and published this twenty first day of August one thousand seven hundred eighty six in the presence of us.

I Joseph Roads, being sick in body but of perfect mind and sound in memory and calling to mind the mortality of this life and knowing that it is appointed once for all men to die I do constitute and ordain this my last will and Testament in the manner as following first of all I give and Recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it and my body to be discreetly buried at the Discretion of my Executors in a Christian like manner and as touching such worldly goods as it Pleas God to Bless me with I give in the manner following I constitute and appoint my Beloved Elizabeth as my heir and sole Executrix after paying all my just debts first of I give as follows to my Beloved son John Roads Jr I give and bequeath one shilling Sterling of my Estate and to my daughter Mary Roads to her I give and bequeath one shilling Sterling of my Estate and to my Beloved wife Elizabeth I give and bequeath all the Remain and Residue of my Estate both Real and personal bearing her Natural Life or Middle Age and at her Decease to my Grand daughter Mary make the wife of William Prescott I give and bequeath to her all my Lands and stock of ever kind and my house hold furniture to be Equally Divided betwixt my five Grand Children the heirs of my daughter Mary Roads and James Roads Jr I constitute and appoint here an Executor also with Beloved wife Elizabeth Roads and I do finally Revokes and Disannuls and Repeals all other wills before by me made and do only acknowledge this my last will and testament.
