

In the name of God amen I David Hall of Beaufort
Barrenet County, being of sound and perfect mind and
memory (Bless be God) do this twentieth day of January
in the year of our Lord 1800 Make and publish this my
last will and Testament in manner following that is to say

First

I give to my son Martin Hall forty acres of land
part out of that I purchased of Jonathan Hilde and part
out of Benjamin Leecraft to pay the eastward of its due
to Nathl. Hilde line part of the land bought of
Benj^a Leecraft with the plantation and as much of the
wood land as will make up forty acres bought of Nathl
Hilde, to be delivered to him when he comes to the age
of Twenty-one. --

Second

I give to my son Samuel Hall the plantation I bought
of Benjamin Leecraft with all the wood land thereto belong-
ing with as much of that I bought of Hilde joining the said
Leecraft land as will make forty acres, to be delivered
him when he comes of age.

Third

I give the Remainder of that piece I bought of said Hilde
to my son Joseph Hall, to be delivered him when he
comes of age.

Fourth

I give to my son David Hall that piece of land I purchased
of John Telford with all the marshes thereto belonging to be
delivered him when he comes of age.

Fifth

I give to my son Richard Hall the piece of Land I pur-
chased of Benj^a Leecraft to be delivered him when
he comes of age. Likewise the house and Lot in
Beaufort I now live in after the death of his mother.

Sixth

I give to my three Daughters each a Negro Girl
Sarah, Lucretia, Rachel Phillis Jane Janny to be delivered
them when of age or married. --

Seventh

I give to my son John Hall one cow and calf to
be delivered him when he calls for them out of
my flock which is full of my Estate.

Eighth

I give the use of all my Estate unto my wife Naomi
that I have not given away during her natural life
for the purpose of maintaining her self and Children
the Remainder of all my Estate not above mentioned
to be equally divided, after her death, between my
Children Martin Samuel Sarah Joseph Rachel
David Jane and Richard.

Ninth

I Give my wife during her Lifetime the house and
Lot she now lives in with a negro woman Sarah
and after her death the Negro to be divided

amongst my Children Martin Samuel Sarah Joseph
Rachel David Jane & Richard in case of any of the
said Children should die before they come of age then
their part or parts to be equally divided amongst the
rest of my Children before mentioned.

Tenth

I leave my wife Naomi my Executrix Martin and
Samuel Hall my Executors of this my last will and
Testament, in witness whereof I the said David Hall
have to this my last will and Testament set my hand
and Seal this day and year above written
