Bell who has taken care of me, I give my own land on Calies Creek heirs from my father (one seventh) $\frac{1}{7}$ of the land that my mother dowerd on, with whatever individual estate both Real and Personal or all that I may hereafter have to my said son Oscar G. Bell to have and hold to him and his heirs in fee simple forever. And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my said son Oscar G. Bell my lawful Executor to all intents and purposes. He executes this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same and every part and clause thereof hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other Wills and Testaments by me heretofore made.
