First I Give to my loving wife Esther Hatarell during her Natural life or widowhood All my lands negroes Swine cattle Hogs & sheep Household & Kitchen Furniture with all other due me Everything that I possess of this world's Goods and at her death or marriage I Give the Half of the above property to my children & wife should she may be Equally divided betwixt them all.

2nd I authorize my executors to sell any part of my property to pay my debts that they think proper or can spare best.

I do appoint my loving wife Esther Hatarell & My son William Hatarell Executors to this my last Will and Testament I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the day and date above Written.

Be it known and Remembered that I Elizabeth Hill of Carteret County in the State of North Carolina being weak in Body but of sound disposing mind and memory, do this the thirtieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteen, make this my last Will and Testament in the following manner. In the first place my Will and desire is that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid by my Executors hereinafter named.

Item. I Give unto my son Edward B. Hill my Negro Girl Sam to have his hair and assigns for ever. I also Give unto my Son Edward B. Hill all my Stock of cattle and sheep except two cows and calves and six pigs and Lambs to have his hair and assigns for ever. Also one Bed and furniture and Bedstead and all my Housefurnish to him his hair and assigns for ever.

Item. I Give unto my son John Hill one Bedstead and furniture. Also my two mules to him his hair and assigns for ever.

Item. I Give unto my Daughter Dinah Hill two cows and calves and six pigs and Lambs to her her hair and assigns for ever.

Item. I Give unto my two Daughters Pamela and Simada all my spun stuff to them their hair and assigns for ever.

Item. I Give to my Daughter Dinah Hill my six Bona and my set of China cups and Saucers and Silver Tea Spoon to her her hair and assigns for ever.

Lastly Resolving all former I constitute and appoint my son John Hill my Executor to execute this my last Will and Testament according to the true intent and meaning thereof.
