The foregoing written paper was then
 exhibited into open Court and duly proved by the oath
 of James H. Hunt one of the subscribing witnesses therein
 who swore that he saw Robert Read one of the other
 witnesses sign with him self as such and James Chadwick
 and Allen Davis the executors therein named qualified
 as such and Letters Testamentary ordered to issue
 H. Rumley C. C.

In the name of God, Amen, I Esther Cooke of the County
 of Carteret and State of North Carolina, being of sound
 and perfect mind and memory, do make this my last
 will and testament -

I give and bequeath unto my son James M.
 Cooke and his sister Harriet Cooke all my real and personal
 property whatever to be equally divided between them -
 provided that if my children James M. Cooke and Harriet
 Cooke should die without issue, then I give and bequeath
 all my real and personal property as above bequeathed
 to my Aunt Esther Bowden and Mary Selome, to have and
 their heirs forever.

I appoint Joseph Bowden and Henry M. Cooke
 of the County of Carteret and State of North Carolina
 aforesaid my lawful executors -
