I Ezekiel Hunter of Barbours County, Delaware, being in a
 poor state of health, but of perfect mind & memory & should
 it please God to take me off. It is my will & desire that my
 Estate should be Divided as follows -

Item I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Jennie Duly,
 a Negro wench coulda bill & her child - Phelaly, also
 a mare coulda fly, to her her hairs & assigns forever.

Item, I give & beq^t. to my daughter Ruth
 Duly, a negro wench coulda ferry & her child Fenty,
 to her, her, & assigns forever.

Item, I give & beq^t. to my daughter Elizth
 Bell, a Negro fellow coulda Fortune, also three
 Thousand pounds in money, to her hairs & assigns
 forever -

Item I Give & beq^t. to my Daughter, Lacey, Two
 negro girls, one coulda judd the other mill, one more
 boy that so coulda here also a bed, four sheets, one
 Rugg one Blanket one Bolster & two pillows, to be
 of her own choosing, to her her hairs & assigns forever
 also the saddle coulda here -

Item I Give & bequeath to my son Jethro the
 Plantation whereon I now live, with all the Land &
 Improvements there belonging, one Negro wench
 coulda Ester, her child Lacey, Two negro Boys Friday &
 Patrick, one Bed, four sheets one Rugg, one Blanket, one
 Bolster & two pillows, one Black mare coulda pleasure,
 & the Horse coulda his own, Two saddles & bridles,
 one Gun, also a small pair of Cartwheels - To him
 his hairs & assigns forever - The four last articles,
 say Horse saddles & bridles Gun & Cartwheels, to be
 Emsaidly for my sons use & disposal -

The remaining part of my Estate not mentioned
 To be Equally divided, between all my Children, By
 a person Chose by each Child.

Should my son Jethro die under the age of Twenty
 one years, then his Estate to be Equally divided between
 my four Daughters, By persons Chose as above -

I Give all the right I have or may have, to a tract
 or parcel of Land whereon Stephen weath now
 lives, & is Contained for in Law, By said weath & my
 self; to my three Daughters, say Jennie, Ruth &
 Elizabeth, to be sued for, sold or hired, as they
 may think proper, To them their hairs &

assigns forever.

The Estate Left to my son Jethro, to be let on the
 best Terms can by the year, to maintain & school him,
 at the discretion of my Executors, the whole to be kept
 as much together as possible on the plantation.

The battle gave to Lacey by her brand master
 & three coulda gestures, to be reserved to them, and not
 divided with the rest, also one cow I am have to my son
 Lacey & is in his own name.

I Do Appoint, Thomas Dudley, Abraham Dudley,
 David Bell & George Mitchell, my whole & sole
 Executors - & this I acknowledge to be my last will
 & Testament as witness my hand this 1780
