 three sons and after my Wife death or marriage
 I give and bequith to my two younger Son Jeann
 Bell and newell Bell ^{the} said house and land
 Wharin I now Deell and if either of them should
 dye Without - air then his part is to be equilly
 Devided between my two Daughters I give to my
 son Nathaniel Bell one cow by the of ^{and} Pindie to
 my son Jeann Bell one best Calf and heiffer
 Dayer and Blatky to my daughter Roseanna
 mordon one cow and Calf redy and a two
 year old heifer to my son newel Bell one cow
 and calf By the of White flank to my daug
 Mary bell one two year old heifer by the name
 of Blossom and the Remainder cattle to be left
 to my Wife during her natril Life and then to
 be equely devied amongst my children to my
 Rosa one sow and piggs to one hundred of
 land lying Betw cedon town and the River
 to the Work or sold to the use of my family
 and as for the house hold furniture i geave to
 my wife during her Widshood and if married
 it is to be equely devied Between my children
 and her.

Lastly I have nominated and apinted my
 Said Beloved Will Mary bell and my loving
 Brother abner Bell Excutrive and Excutor of
 my last Will and Testament - hear by
 Renouncing all former Wills by me made
 Whare of i have heareunto set my hand
 and seal this third day of September 1791
