Imprimis, my will and desire is that all my just debts before

then I give to my daughter Sarah Stewart a piece of land beginning at her dwelling house, Channing and running parallel to the back side, then to a cart road that leads from the

northeast corner of my plantation to the main road bounding on said road and backside and Stewart line, to the beginning, also a negro woman named Mitilda without increase and a negro girl named Mary, I give to my grand son Alexander Stewart and all of his increase, to them and their heirs forever, all of the above named property is to remain in the possession of my wife Mary Chadwick, during her natural life or widowhood no longer I give to my son John Chadwick one negro man named Yabiah, and a negro girl named Hannah, and his increase, to him and his heirs forever, the above named negroes to remain in the possession of my wife Mary Chadwick, during her natural life or widowhood and no longer.

I give to my son James Chadwick, one negro man named Pempana and named Leck, to him and his heirs forever, the above named negroes to remain in the possession of my Mary Chadwick, during her natural life or widowhood and no longer I give to my son Isaac Chadwick the house and land that I bought of Thaddeus Chadwick beginning at the mouth of a small gulch to the eastward of the house and running up the gulch nearly to the Corp fence then parallel to the Corp fence as a different distance from it, for a cart way to a stake or cluster of Cedar and Cherry trees, then a south westerly course to the water so as to give twelve feet to the eastward of the mill race and then along the water to the beginning, also the wood land that lies to the eastward of the cart road that leads from the northeast corner of my plantation to the main road, also the land that I bought on ^{NEWS RIVER?} of the

executors of Samuel Chadwick decd. to him and his heirs forever all of the above described property to remain in the possession of my wife Mary Chadwick during her natural life or widowhood and no longer.
