memory do make and ordain this my last will and testa-
ment in manner and form following, ^{by}
In presence, my will and desire is that all my just debt before
I give to my daughter Jane Stewart open of land beginning
at her dwelling house, Channing and running parallel to
Anne Gaskie, then to a cart road that leads from the

north east corner of my plantation to the main road leading
on said road and Gaskie and Stewart lines, to the beginning also
a Negro woman named Hilda without increase and a Negro
man named Harry I give to my grand son Alexander Stewart
me all of his Increase, to him and their heirs forever, all of the
a house property to remain in the possession of my wife
Mary Chadwick, during her natural life or widowhood no longer
I give to my son John Chadwick one Negro man named Gabriel
a Negro girl named Hammah and her Increase, to him and
his heirs forever, the above named negro to remain in the possession
of my wife Mary Chadwick, during her natural life or
widowhood and no longer

I give to my son George Chadwick, one Negro man named
Empana and named Dick, to him and his heirs forever, the above
named negro to remain in the possession of my Mary Chadwick,
during her natural life or widowhood and no longer
I give to my son Israel Chadwick the house and land that
I bought of Thaddeus Chadwick beginning at the mouth of a small
run to the eastward of the house and running up the run nearly
to the Creek fence then parallel to the Creek fence at a sufficient distance
from it for a cart way to a state or cluster of Cedars and Cherry trees,
then a northwardly course to the water so as to give twelve feet
to the eastward of the river bank and then along the water to the
beginning, also the wood land, then less to the eastward of the Creek
bank that leads from the north east corner of my plantation to
the main road, also the land less ^{NEWS RIVER?} I bought on permission of the
executors of Anna Chadwick decd. to him and his heirs forever

all of the above described property to remain in the possession of my
wife Mary Chadwick during her natural life or widowhood
and no longer

I leave to my daughter Elizabeth Chadwick during her natural
life one negro boy named Allen, and one name Henry, and
one named Dennis, also a negro woman named Eliza, and a
girl named Lucy, with their Increase, and then to go to her law
for her forever, all of the above named negro to remain

in the possession of my wife Mary Chadwick during her life or widowhood and no longer -

Item 6th I give to my daughter Polly Chadwick during her life one sugar boy named Jude and a sugar woman Linda and him I release from this time, and then to gather lawfull heir forever, I also grant him the priviledge of occupying one half of my house and out-houses as long as she may think proper to live there and no longer the above named sugar and pesselges to remain in the possession of my wife Mary Chadwick during her natuaral life or widowhood and no longer -

Item 7th I give to my son Nathaniel Chadwick two sugar boys named Jollford and one named Wallow also one half the land to the south of the Crop fence to be laid off adjoining the Crop fence and as near a square as the nature of the will admits by a line running eastwardly from the corner also one half of the wood land that I have now already laid off to be laid off on the eastward part of the same with all my sports river land to him and his heirs for ever the above named property to remain in the possession of my wife Mary Chadwick during her natuaral life or widowhood and no longer -

Item 8th I give to my son Simeon Chadwick Plantation House and all other out-houses with the land adjoining thereto living being the other half of the cleared land on the north of Crop fence adjoining thereto which I have given to my son Nathaniel Chadwick, also the balances of my wood land being one half of the tract of which I have given my son Nathaniel Chadwick to be laid off on the westward part of the same, also two sugar boys one named Edward and one named Louis to him and his heirs forever the above named property to remain in the possession of my wife Mary Chadwick during her natuaral life or widowhood and no longer -

Item 9th I give to my wife Mary Chadwick all the movable part-

of my property that I have not mentioned or will add to my children to hold any of my children die without lawfull heirs my will and desire is that what ever property I have may will it to them equally between and be equally divided among the surviving brothers and sisters -

I do hereby appoint as my executors to this my last will and testament John Chadwick, Gayed Chadwick, Sarah Chadwick, Nathaniel Chadwick, and Simeon Chadwick, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal 26th September 1834.
