mind and memory being sensible of my mortality and for the  
quiet of my family do make this my last Will and Testament  
in form following Chief of all I commend my Soul to God who  
gave it - to my Lord the Son of Jesus Christ my Redeemer and my  
body to the Earth to be decently Buried at the discretion of  
my Executors hereafter mentioned and as for such worldly  
Goods as God hath been pleased to bless me with I  
dispose of the same as follows.

First of all I give to my Daughter Hannah Made all  
the Goods and Chattels that I now have at Thomas Madells  
and one pair of hand Irons and one large stone pot and  
one three yellow Stone Jug and one large Iron Kettle and one  
Iron Roasting spit at Thomas Hay to her and her heirs and  
assigns for ever. also I give to my Daughter Hannah Made  
one Cart and wheels that Thomas Hay had of mine to her  
and her heirs and assigns for ever. also I give to my grand son  
Charles Hay one Feather Bed that Thomas Hay has in care and  
one two year old heifer and one Iron Sallet and one fuller  
Broom to him and his heirs and assigns for ever. also I give  
to my son Thomas Hay all the Remainder part of my Estate  
that is not already Willed away to him and his heirs and  
assigns for ever and I do hereby make and appoint Hannah  
Made my full and sole Executrix of this my last Will  
and Testament hereby Revoking Disannulling and making  
void all former Wills and bequests by me made & declar-  
ing this only to be my last Will and Testament in  
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
Seal this thirty first Day of January Anno Domini 1773.
